MUSC At A Glance

- Extensive healthcare network including 8 hospitals, 1600 beds, 100 outreach sites, 6 colleges and 275 telehealth locations
- Providing education, research and patient care
- #1 hospital in the state for 5 consecutive years
- Federally recognized as one of two National Telehealth Centres of Excellence by the HRSA

Vidyo Provides Improved Telehealth Opportunities

After the initial launch of MUSC's telehealth program to support the mostly rural state of South Carolina, problems from initial video conferencing provider included:



Failed connections in low bandwidth situations



Slow deployment of secure and effective solutions



Lack of ability to transform outpatient visits into telehealth visits

Vidyo Provides Improved Telehealth Opportunities

MUSC used Vidyo to seek better results, like:

- Offering stable connections in low-bandwidth situations that are found in many rural regions
- MUSC was able to transition from a single hospital into a health care system
- Requiring minimal in-house IT assistance
- Integrating with healthcare software including EPIC, myChart and GetWell
- Saving \$1 million in non-emergency department (ED) interventions during single county pilot program that implemented Vidyo solutions into its ambulances
- Vast other uses including stroke care, OBGYN visits, drug and addiction counselling, etc...



COVID-19 Exposes Need to Expand Telehealth

The pandemic created an immediate need to transition most of MUSC's in-person services to telehealth meetings:

- **1400%** increase in virtual patient visits between the months of March to May
- Doctors had to continue interacting with their patients from afar
- Patients needed an option for safe virtual visits from their loved ones



Patient Interaction During COVID-19

Vidyo's remote deployment of virtual solutions to support MUSC was able to:


Transition most **inpatient and outpatient visits** into telehealth appointments in a four-week window

Allow for **low-bandwidth capability** so doctors stayed connected to rural patients with poor connectivity


Enable **safe and secure video conferencing** solutions that promoted human interactions when visitors were not allowed

The Results of Using the Vidyo Solution


By using Vidyo's solutions during the pandemic, MUSC was able to:




Connect doctors and patients 30 miles apart through the deployment of over 200 iPads in less than 4 weeks



Reduce the cost of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) that had inflated 700% during the outbreak through limiting in-person interactions



Increase patient satisfaction by offering socially distant doctor-patient visits



Number of trips into COVID+ patient rooms greatly decreased helping to protect healthcare workers
